



# THE FULLMELT FILTRATION PREFERRED SET-UP METHOD

Tutorial no 2 explains the Fullmelt Filtration preferred set-up method.

## WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- 2 buckets (minimum).
- Ice (RO preferred) – 10Kg to 300 – 500g of herbal material.
- Water (RO preferred) – 10L per 100g.
- Mixing spoon.
- FullMelt Filtration bags.
- Paper towels.
- Scooping spoon.
- Drying screen.

## STEP 1 SET UP THE FILTRATION COLUMN (BUCKET A)

- Add the 38 micron filter bag to the bucket.
- Fold the rim of the bag over the rim of the bucket to secure it in place.
- Push the screen down towards the base of the bucket.
- Add the 70 Micron filter bag, followed by the 120, 160, 190, 250 in the same fashion as the 38 micron Filter bag.

## STEP 2 PREP THE HERBAL MATERIAL FOR WASHING

- Into Bucket B, add ice (5cm), add herbal material, add ice (10cm) and add water.
- Fill bucket up to three quarters water (Do not overfill the bucket).

- Let the material chill in the ice water for 15-30 minutes.
- Mix, gently for 5-15 minutes.
- Pour mix through filtration column from bucket B into bucket A.
- Remove each bag in descending order.
- Collect herbal resin from each bag as you go.
- Add wet resin to the drying screen (paper towel, spoon).
- Repeat steps 1 & 2 (2-10 times)

## STEP 3 CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Between washes, use cold water to rinse the screens.
- After washing – Soak screens in Ethanol for 30 seconds and then rinse with cold water.
- If screens are still sticky, repeat the process until the screens are clean.
- Rinse thoroughly and leave to dry in a shady spot.
- Once dry, fold the bags and store in the handy FullMelt Filtration Carrier bag. Add wet resin to the drying screen (paper towel, spoon).
- Repeat steps 1 & 2 (2-10 times).

## STEP 4 FOLD AND PACK

- Open bag on flat surface with the number on the top right facing you.
- Fold the bag in half (vertically).
- Fold the bag in half again (vertically).
- Put the bag print side down.
- Fold up the screen.
- Roll up bag into cylinder.
- Fold the handle over the side of the cylinder.
